Dear IEB Volunteer,

I would like to thank you for participating in the Incredible Edible Brandon (IEB) program. These gardens will be open to the public to harvest from at their convenience. Your contributions are greatly appreciated by the IEB team. Our vision focuses on three 'spinning plates': **community** (working in and with your local community), **learning** (helping people learn about food, from cradle to grave) and **business** (supporting and promoting local producers and suppliers). By coming together and working on these gardens, you are helping to achieve a better sense of "community".

Volunteers will not be expected to tend to the garden every day, though they are responsible for the continual upkeep of their designated planter(s). Our hope is that volunteers will spend approximately one hour per week maintaining their designated garden and inform us if at any time during the season they are no longer available to maintain their planter(s). Maintenance includes: weeding, deadheading, replanting, staking, trellising, and any other regular needs of the garden planter. With this effort, we hope to have the gardens looking their best throughout the entire summer. There will be routine checks by floaters or committee members on each planter for replanting, weeding, staking, and trellising needs. Seeds, plants, staking, signage and trellising materials will be available through the committee. It would be beneficial to bring materials such has gloves, trowels, kneepads, etc. Watering of the plants will be taken care of by the City of Brandon through their watering schedule. Volunteers are not paid for their work on the planters.

Planters will be planted on Thursday May 25<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers are encouraged to bring shovels, gloves and trowels with them. Family and friends are welcome, but the work environment will not be ideal for small children. The Grand Opening will follow on Saturday May 27<sup>th</sup> in association with Eco Day in May including a fundraising potluck for the project from 9-11am. The project will wrap up by September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
